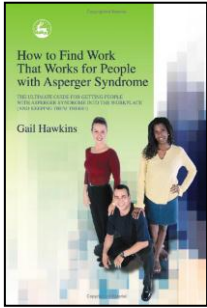




Transition to Work Inventory

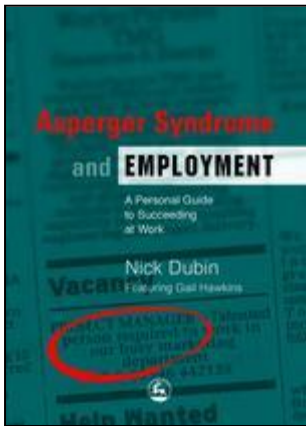
